

Pupil Premium Spending

The School receives an allocation of Pupil Premium Grant each year. This funding is specifically allocated to improve attainment for pupils who are eligible for free school meals and children in care.

Pupil Premium 2013-2014

Funding of £39,850 was allocated for 2013-2014. The allocation was used to employ two additional Support Assistants with a focus on attainment of disadvantaged pupils, throughout KS2. In addition pupils in year 6 received additional targeted tuition which included one-one support from a Learning Support Additional Teacher. Pupils in KS1 received daily reading intervention support.

Following analyses of the impact of funding for 2012-13 we set some key objectives for our spending for 2013-14

Objectives: To raise the attainment and improve the progress of those pupils entitled to the PPG. To significantly close the attainment gap between pupils at St. Laurence's Primary and the attainment of pupils nationally. To support vulnerable pupils and to provide opportunities to access the wider curriculum through by subsidising residential trips, music tuition and other extra-curricular activities.
