Please do join in and have a go if you can – as always, all proceeds made benefit the children in so many ways.

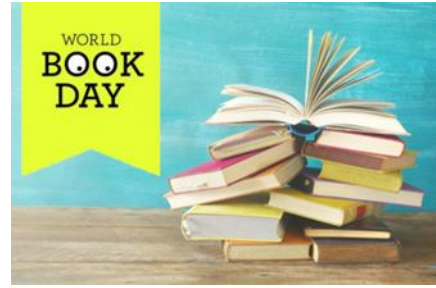
