

<p>English Summer 1 In English, we will be sharing the story of The Last Wolf. The children will develop their letter writing skills with an emphasis on persuasive writing. We will also be sharing Fantastic Mr Fox in our reading time.</p> <p>Summer 2 After half term, we will be sharing the fiction text of Grandad’s Secret Giant where children will learn to retell the story but with a focus on morals and acceptance of others.</p>		<p>Science Summer 1 We will be exploring living things and their habitats. We will explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive. Children will also look at habitats and micro-habitats and explore the food chain.</p> <p>Summer 2 We will be looking at plants looking at bulbs and plants and how they mature. We will find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.</p>		<p>Maths Summer 1 We will start off revisiting our multiplication of 2’s, 5’s and 10’s and look at division structures. We will then be learning about money, fractions and time.</p> <p>Summer 2 To finish the year, will revisit multiplication, division linked with doubling and halving. Children will then explore their sense of measure thinking about capacity, volume and mass.</p>	
<p>Computing Children will be learning to code and will be learning what an algorithm is and will be making their own codes using collision detection tools. The children will create and evaluate their own seascapes, applying paint in different ways, using sponges and large, bold brushstrokes to create a stormy sea and sky.</p>		<p>History – Nurturing Nurses Over this unit we will be thinking about the lives of Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale and the changes in nursing over time. We will be sequencing their lives in a chronological order and making comparisons over time.</p>
